

WCSD Goals and Objectives

1) Families, community members, staff, and students will collaborate with transparent, respectful, and timely communication to ensure a culture of mutual success.

a) **Objective One:** 10% decrease in parents' perception that teachers do not communicate effectively with parents by June 2017.

b) **Objective Two:** 15% decrease in referrals regarding disrespectful student behavior by June 2016 and 25% reduction by June 2017.

c) **Objective Three:** 75% of parents will agree that teachers communicate effectively with parents by June 2017.

d) **Objective Four:** 75% of staff will feel families are involved in school by June 2017.

e) **Objective Five:** 75% of parents will agree that staff, faculty and administration work together with them to improve education for students by June 2017.

2) All students will be provided a diverse, challenging and engaging education through innovative teaching methods and extracurricular opportunities to maximize academic engagement and achievement of all students.

a) **Objective One:** 100% of students will be involved in an extracurricular activity by June 2018.

b) **Objective Two:** 100% of staff will feel differentiated instruction is a strength in their curriculum development by June 2018.

c) **Objective Three:** All instructional staff will participate in at least one day of professional development annually by June 2018.

d) **Objective Four:** 75% of students will describe their classes as interesting and challenging by 2018. (Fall survey of five questions)

3) All students will graduate from WCS with the necessary skills and confidence to be contributing citizens.

a) **Objective One:** High School completion rates for all students will exceed 85% when averaged over three years by June 2018.

b) **Objective Two:** 85% of students will be reading at or above grade level in third and sixth grade as measured by AIMSWEB by June 2017.

c) **Objective Three:** 90% of students will feel they fit in by June 2017.

d) **Objective Four:** 10% annual increase in mastery scores for all students on integrated Algebra State Assessments by June 2017.

e) **Objective Five:** Student mastery scores in all state testing and regents tested classes will increase 5% by June 2017.

f) **Objective Six:** Advanced regents diplomas for all students will be at least 45% by June 2017.
